The Dorking Schools' Partnership is pleased to announce that this special event has been arranged on behalf of all of the local primary schools.

Would you like to know more about keeping your child safe when they use social media on smart phones, tablets or gaming devices such as X-Box, or are on-line? If so, we would recommend you attend this event to give you the information you need.

Run by Eagle Radio, this session is specifically targeted at parents and focuses on how to safely message and communicate with others online and how to help parents check their child's on-line activity and settings.

The programme goes into detail about the specific laws around Sexting (sending sexual content) and Cyber Bullying (hate speech, threats, and offensive/malicious messages) and the best way to deal with the issues around these, looking at potential scenarios and discussion time about how to deal with each scenario. It will also talk about the reasons for the issues we face with social media, as well as some of the emerging topics and some real life case studies that have featured in the news and how police dealt with each case.

This event is free and is designed for the parents of children aged KS2/9-11 years old.

A peer support group for adults caring for a young person with mental health issues

I am delighted to let you know that our Help for the Helper ongoing support group will start on Monday the 3rd of July. As a result of the feedback received from the recent talk about help for adults caring for a young person with mental health issues we will be starting a monthly support group. It will be on the first Monday of the month from 7.30-9pm at the Malthouse Youth Centre, Mill Lane, Dorking. The first group will take place on the 3rd of July 2017.

The group will be open to adults caring for or supporting young people with mental health issues. It is a peer support group which means no mental health professional is present but volunteers have been trained in facilitating an open group and are able to signpost to local and national services if required.

The group will start with a welcome, introductions, inspirational reading regarding mental health then time for sharing about personal challenges and of course time for socialising.
