I am delighted that our Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMs) was a great success yesterday however I am not able to share the judgements until the final report is published. As always, the children were amazing and we are all extremely proud of them.

On Thursday 2nd March, we will be celebrating World Book Day. All staff and children are invited to come to school dressed as a character from their favourite book and I am sure that you will welcome the advance notice. We are currently finalising activities to celebrate Shakespeare week too (20-27th March).

It is that time of year again! The Radio 2 500 Words competition is now OPEN. This is a successful story-writing competition for children which we encourage our children to take part in. In total, nearly half a million pupils have written a story for the judges to read; that's over 277 MILLION words!

It's very simple. Entrants write an original story on any subject or theme in 500 Words or fewer and submit it online. If they win, their story will be read live on the radio by a superstar celebrity...like Julie Walters, Tom Hiddleston, Sir Kenneth Branagh, Jeremy Irons, or Sherlock himself – Benedict Cumberbatch. Each year, 10 million Radio 2 listeners hear, read and love these stories. If your child submits an entry, please can you encourage him/her to bring in a copy to share on our Writing Wall? I look forward to reading their entries.

Next week, there is an opportunity to experience a Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar workshop. It will give an insight into current teaching strategies and how these are used to enhance children's reading and writing. There will also be top tips on how to support your child with home learning and ideas for activities. We hope you will be able to attend a workshop.


