IN THE SCHOOL HALL ALL WELCOME!

Good afternoon. Welcome to our first newsletter of December, time is really flying by.

Today is the day of the Christmas Fair - many thanks in advance to everyone who has donated items, offered their time and to those who will be attending. I look forward to seeing as many of you there as possible. This is one of the major fundraising events for the school during the academic year and all the funds raised will be ploughed back directly into the school to benefit your children. F@SH will in due course let you know how much was raised and how the funds will be spent.

The children are becoming increasingly excited about all the Christmas activities and we have put out our post boxes for your children to post cards should they wish. Please ensure that the envelopes have the child's name and class, so that they can be easily sorted and delivered.

Now that the nights are darker could we please ask that those of you who let children walk home alone or in groups, unaccompanied by an adult, review these arrangements. Police alerts about child safety increase fourfold during the winter period. Ideally, anyone walking should be wearing some form of reflective clothing.

Children of primary age should not be cycling unaccompanied. NB Only Year 6 may do this once they have passed their Cycling Proficiency later in the year. Even then, they should not be cycling home alone in the dark.

The safest thing is for you to meet your child at the school gate where there is a member of staff on duty but if this is not possible, please reinforce with your child that they must return to the school office if you do not arrive to pick them up at the agreed time. Children should not have mobile phones in school as the school office is a reliable point of contact. However, if your Year 6 child does have to walk alone, particularly if you are developing their independence prior to secondary school, and you wish to provide them with a phone for contacting you on their way, this **must** be left at the school office in the morning and collected at the end of the day.
