It has been a busy first week back at school. Maths week has been very successful; it was amazing to see the creative costumes yesterday. All of the children enjoyed the workshops that challenged their mathematical thinking. A big thank you to Mrs Kong for arranging the week and fun challenges. Thank you also to the staff who led the informative mathematics parent workshops which were well attended. If you were unable to attend the meeting a set of the notes will be sent home to you.

We have spent this time this week reviewing the books in our reading scheme to ensure they are appropriate and will engage your child. This is one of the actions from our school development plan as we know that reading has a huge impact on improving writing. Gaps in the reading scheme have been identified so the money donated by F@SH will be used to purchase new books. In addition, books have been identified to support children as they move from the reading scheme to free readers, these are labelled brown, ruby and black. There will be more information about the importance of reading with your children, especially in Key Stage 2, and the school reading scheme at our workshops for parents on the 28th November for Year 1 and 2 and the 29th November for Years 3, 4, 5 and 6.

MATHS WEEK This has been a great success and the children have really enjoyed the extra focus on maths this week. All took part in outdoor challenges with zest – applying their problem solving skills and working well with others. We also had a Maths Workshop on both sites and the children enjoyed their maths mufti day – some very interesting ideas were paraded including a human calculator, creative use of playing cards and a number king!





'Working in mixed year groups gave us different perspectives about the questions. This made us think about the best approach to solve the problems.' (Leo Yr 6). 'I enjoyed coming into school on mufti day and see everyone else's maths costumes.' (Syun – Yr 3).

Years one and two have enjoyed looking at maths throughout the curriculum. For this week's artwork the children in year one used shapes to make some 'rangoli' patterns and year two used the artist 'Kandinsky's' work as

inspiration for their shape pictures. The children have also enjoyed working with their friends to solve problems on a maths hunt. They have also enjoyed working with their friends on maths games and challenges. This week Reception have been outside on a Maths challenge trail measuring our steps around the boat and the playground. We have been watching Numberjacks to help us with our numeral recognition. We dressed up and recognised the numbers on each other and we had lots of fun with counting everything and anything.
