


Can you please make sure that you do not send in any food containing nuts, particularly in packed lunches. This includes biscuits and snacks containing nuts, peanut butter, walnut cake, Nutella etc. It may not always be obvious that nuts are included in the ingredients of some snacks, so we would appreciate your vigilance in checking before food is brought into school. Thank you for your support and understanding.

Earrings Only small studs are acceptable for school. In line with school and Surrey County policy earrings should be removed by the child or taken out in the morning by parents on PE days. Staff are not allowed to take out/put in earrings. If you are thinking of having your child's ears pierced we recommend having this done at the start of the summer holidays.

School gateway School Gateway

To further reduce our carbon footprint we will be sending ALL letters home via School Comms. So you don't miss any important information we will list all the letters sent home **from the school office** during the week on the front of the Newsletter. Paper copies will be available from the office on request. The school's communication and payment system, if you haven't set up your account already please follow the instruction below. If you have any difficulties please contact the school office.

The system is called School Gateway – and it's available for you to use now.

- 1. Go to www.schoolgateway.com
- 2. When you visit the School Gateway website for the first time, please select 'New User' and enter your email address and mobile telephone number you have registered with the school
- 3. The system will send a PIN code to your phone; please enter this PIN code and your account will be activated for you.

As soon as you've got the system set-up, you'll be able to pay money to the school online rather than send cash or cheques.

If you've recently changed your email address or mobile telephone number, please let us know so we can update our records.

Data Collection Sheets

You should have received a Data Collection Sheet this week via your child. Please could you check that all the details are correct and amend where necessary. It would be very helpful, if you could include your main email address, whether it a work or home email address.
