



# Good To Be Green

**Good to be Green** is our behaviour system that helps us all to make good choices about our behaviour and be noticed and rewarded when we make good choices.

This leaflet will give you more information about how **Good to be Green** works at Surrey Hills School.

## How does Good to be Green Work?

Each class has a colour chart in their classroom. Everyday each child starts the day with their name on green. The aim is to stay on green all day.

If children make good choices about their behaviour they will stay on **green** or even have the chance to move their name to **silver** or **gold**. By staying on green they earn a **green point** for their class. On silver or gold they achieve a special sticker.

## Gold

If children achieve a gold sticker they will be allowed to go to a senior member of staff to tell them how they achieved it.

## Consequences

If children continue to make a poor choice their name may be moved to **red**. If this happens there will be a consequence and they may need to complete their learning elsewhere or fill in a reflection sheet. They can then start making good choices and get back to **green**.

## Warnings

If children make poor choices about their behaviour they will be given a verbal warning and then moved to **orange** if the behaviour continues. This is just a reminder that they need to correct their behaviour and if they start making good choices their name will be moved up to **green**.

## Whole Class Reward

Each class has a **green point** total that is added to each day. If a pupil stays on green or above all day they automatically get a green point toward the whole class total. When the class reaches its green point target they get to enjoy their whole class reward.
