Make your own butterfly cafe



You will need

- ✓ Plastic bottle with lid
- ✓ Scissors
- ✓ Decorations/ photos
- ✓ String
- ✓ Water
- ✓ Sugar
- ✓ Soy Sauce
- ✓ Glue

Introduction

Instructions

Step 1



Take a plastic bottle of any size.

Step 2



Very carefully cut off the bottom third with scissors.

Step 3



Punch a hole through the lid with scissors (ask an adult for help!) and push a piece of string through. Tie a knot in the end of the string so it doesn't pull all the way through the bottle cap.

Step 4



Cut the sides of the plastic bottle into petal shapes ensuring you don't cut too far down so it will still hold water.

Step 5



Punch two holes either side for string to be pulled through so it can be hung from a tree or a post.

Step 6



Decorate brightly and then fill with sugar water: 1 teaspoon soy sauce, 1 teaspoon of sugar and mix with water. Your cafe is now ready to be hung outside ready for the butterflies.
