






Hello Squirrels, Rabbits & Hedgehogs,

How to Access and Comment on Blogs

To enable you to share some of your learning and experiences while you're outside of school, we've set up a class blog for you to use. The instructions below show you how to find and use the blog.

- 1. Log on to PurpleMash as normal.
- 2. Click on the 'Sharing' button.



3. Then select 'Shared Blogs' and click on the blog you want to view.



4. To read a blog post, click on the title of the post (it is blue).



5. If you'd like to post a comment about the blog post. Click in the 'Leave the Comment' section at the bottom of the post and write your comment. Then click 'Post Comment'.



Remember: Your comments are visible to all members of the class and the class teacher. They will be checked on a regular basis. You must follow our 'Think' rules when posting messages and **NEVER** post personal information about yourself such as your age, address or telephone number.
