I have found the following options:

Kindle edition (via Amazon): £1.99 (you don't need a kindle but will need to download the kindle app onto a tablet or computer)

Amazon book: £5.99. Amazon states that they are prioritising deliveries but it looks like deliveries would be made within a few days.

There are a few sites offering free download (Kobo.com being one). However, you have to sign up for a free trial. (Although it states subscription can be cancelled at any time, I am unsure how easy this would be).
