1. We do expect you to complete **all of the tasks** that you have been set for English (writing, reading, spelling and/or phonics) and Maths. You can find the expectations for the week on the weekly timetable published each Friday and the maths may include hot, hotter and hottest challenges to choose from. Please complete at least three of the activities set in the learning theme blog over the week.
2. Please ensure that you complete all work to a **high standard**, as you would in school. Your work should be correctly punctuated with capital letters, full stops and basic spellings and high frequency words should be correct. The teacher may set a 're-do' if they feel your child is not producing work to the best of their ability.
3. Please only write posts and comments on blogs that are related to the subject of the blog and correctly punctuated for your child's year group. Anything that is not relevant to the topic of the blog will not be approved and will be deleted as to not confuse things.
4. If you have a problem accessing videos or documents on PurpleMash, please create a post in the 'Problems with PurpleMash' blog. Don't post your problem underneath the learning post. We want to be able to solve your problem as quickly as possible and having to check all of the learning blogs for posts about problems with PurpleMash slows us down!
5. When writing posts and comments on PurpleMash, please remember to be respectful and only write what you would say in person to your teacher or class mate.
6. Please follow the instructions to up-load pictures of your work to PurpleMash. Make sure you tell us when you've done this at the bottom of the relevant blog so that we can have a look at your work. This is the only way teachers can be notified that you have uploaded work for us to look at. Try to upload at least one picture of your Maths work each week so that we can see how you are doing.

We look forward to seeing more of your learning next week and are excited to start publishing the best examples to our class display boards on PurpleMash!
