1:1 Tuition Policy

January 2011

We will offer one-to-one tuition, prioritising children in the following order:

- all looked-after children
- other children who have entered Key Stage 2 below age-related expectation in mathematics or in both reading and writing
- other children judged to be off course to make two levels of progress at the end of the Key Stage
- other children whose progression in mathematics or English, according to our tracking system, has stalled over an extended period
- other children who are considered 'hard to reach' for individual reasons. And whose progress has fallen behind e.g persistent absentees, children with particular behavioural difficulties, those with EAL/language difficulties.

One-to-one tuition will be provided with the specific funding provided by the local authority and children will be prioritised according to the above criteria until all available funding has been used.

Parents will be consulted and permission sought for their child to receive tuition. They will also meet with the teacher at the end of the sessions for a progress report.
