## Attendance

### PENALTY CHARGE NOTICES (PCN)

Government guidance means schools need to consider a Penalty Notice if a pupil misses 10 sessions of unauthorised absence in a rolling period of 10 school weeks. Half a day is considered as a 'session'. The threshold of 10 sessions can be met with any combination of unauthorised absence, for example, eight sessions of unauthorised holidays in term time and two sessions for other unauthorised reasons such as arriving late to school after the register closes.
