

Welcome to a new school year, for some it's their first experience of moving on from a teacher and for others a continuation-but this time being the oldest in the classroom. For everyone, however, there is lots of new learning and activities to experience.

Notes to Parents and Reminders:

Reading – Children should read every day. Reading should be recorded in the reading record (this can be a comment or simply a signature to indicate that home reading has taken place).

Numbots: Numbots is an invaluable resource for improving mental maths skills and quick recall of number facts. The log in will be on the inside cover of your child's reading record book.

Times tables (Year 2) -2, 5 and 10 times tables. Make use of Timestable Rockstars. The log in is the same as Numbots.

Doodle Maths: Another invaluable resource for improving maths skills. A few minutes a day really helps! Log ins will be in the front of your reading record books.

P.E. KITS: PE is on Monday and Tuesday. Forest school is on Wednesday. Children come to school dressed in regulation PE kit only. Please add appropriate layers for the weather.

Punctuality: The official start time of school is 8.45am. The gate is open from 8.30 onwards. Please ensure your child arrives promptly, as learning begins straight away!
