Notes to Parents and Reminders:

Reading – Children should read every day. Please take time to listen and share texts with your child (even if they are competent and confident readers). When you read with your child, please make a note of this in their reading record. Please make sure you fill in the reading challenge (you just need to date and initial it) and this will help them earn their certificates each week.

Spellings – Assignments are set each week (from Sunday to Sunday) on Spelling Shed. Children are expected to complete the set work but, additionally, this resource can be used at any time in order to support children's understanding of spelling patterns. Your child may find it easier to practise spellings on paper instead of on a screen. A homework sheet will be sent out each week for them to complete at home.

Times tables – It is essential to practice frequently. Please make use of **Timetables Rockstars** or use other strategies to ensure all facts are quickly and accurately recalled (to 12 x 12). There is also 'Numbots' (part of TT Rockstars) and Hit the Button. In year 3 we focus on our 3, 4- and 8-times tables. We will also build on the knowledge of the 2, 5- and 10-times tables they have previously learnt in year 2.

P.E. KITS: This term, children should continue to come to school in their full kit on the day/s they have P.E. (white or Surrey Hills' T-shirt, black shorts, socks and trainers – tracksuits will be needed as the weather gets colder). Our PE days are Wednesday and Thursday for this half term.
