Dear Parents/Carers,

We recently held a special Harvest assembly at Abinger, where the children welcomed Abinger Cookery School representatives, who shared their knowledge and expertise about the food we eat. They brought some really interesting vegetables! Thank you Mrs Packer for organising this.

On both sites, Children from each of the year groups led us through a feast of songs, poetry and prayers helping us to reflect on the meaning of Harvest. Thank you to Mrs Grundy, who came in to join the celebrations with us in school; it was lovely to have you there as part of the festival!

Thank you too, to all the families who sent in produce for our harvest collection which we will be delivering to the Food Bank in Dorking, based at the Christian centre.

A reminder of our expectations with regard to school uniform for next half term; all of our children are expected to wear regulation school uniform to school every day. This includes black (indoor) school shoes; we would however ask you to provide a pair of outdoor shoes or wellies in addition to these, to allow the children to continue to play on the school field. This will take place unless we have significant rainfall- play will then be restricted to the playground and astro track.

In November, we will be welcoming prospective parents into school for our annual Open Morning events, for September 2022 intake. This will consist of small groups or individual family tours in the first instance on the 15th and 19th of November. We will make provision for visits beyond the open days and will welcome people by appointment at any point throughout the year.

We are exploring the viability of a virtual tour of the school, an online presentation outlining the provision on offer here at Surrey Hills and a prospectus. It would be enormously helpful if you could share these details with friends and family who you know are looking to choose a school for their child next September or contact Mrs Tudor in the school office for more information.

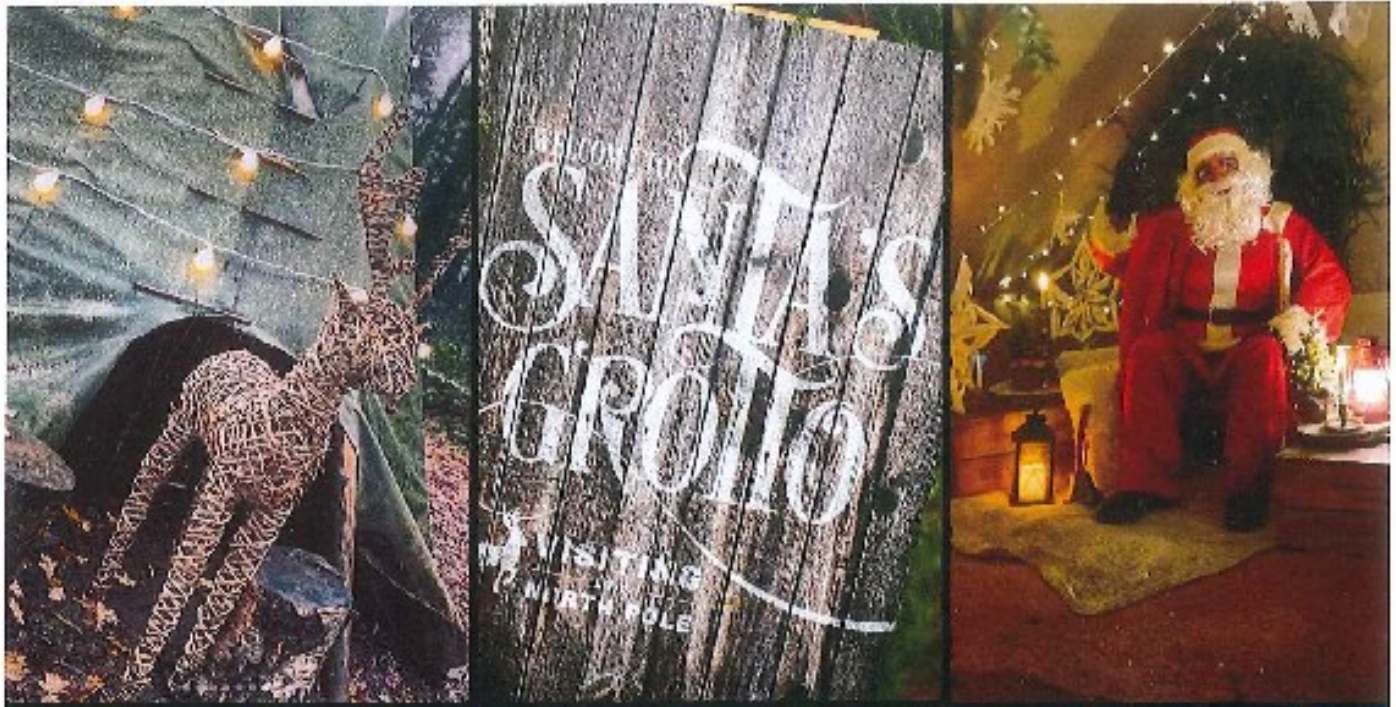
