Science Day

For Science Day, Year five and six learnt about the human heart. In the morning, we dissected a lamb's heart whilst identifying the different parts of the organ. We used knives (under adult supervision) to prise open the muscle; finding heart strings, arteries, the aorta, ventricles and atriums. After, we learnt about line graphs and we recorded our heart rates by running, jumping and walking. We then wrote fact files about the heart from facts we researched on the computers. All in all, we thoroughly enjoyed Science day.

Here are some photo's from our Chromatography experiment today trying to catch the 'Candyman' who left behind a note in black ink after he/she ate all our sweets.


"The colours were fantastic! It was magical to see them explode across the page" Emily, Rabbits Class
