This half term the children in Year Two have enjoyed learning about 'Florence Nightingale' through their 'Enter the Time Machine' topic. The visit from Limelight Theatre Company was greatly enjoyed by both classes.

Children actively participated in the workshop taking on roles as various characters. In addition, the children have also enjoyed taking part in Forest School sessions and

the opportunities that it gave to collaborate with friends. The term has ended with great partnership between the classes on both sites when the children came together to practise for the Christmas nativity.



Reception and Year 1 children have had an exciting term writing and exploring the book Stickman by Julia Donaldson. We have spent time learning about the books characters and writing about them. We used the book to explore our local area and make comparisons. We have also been preparing for Christmas by using this to inspire our maths learning; weighing and measuring quantities, and exploring the features of different shaped presents in our role play areas. We are looking forward to finding out more about next terms topic 'Our World, Your World'.


