Friends at Surrey Hills (F@SH) are the schools volunteer fundraising body who run events throughout the year. Our AGM will take place on 21<sup>st</sup> November at 8.00pm on the Westcott Site. It would be lovely to see lots of you there for a glass of wine and to find some new volunteers!





Good afternoon. We are at the end of another week which has flown by. In fact when I heard the school rehearsing carols in singing assembly, I was reminded how near Christmas is getting.

The HMI monitoring visit on Monday was very positive, the children were welcoming and confident sharing and talking about their learning. I am looking forward to sharing Ms Dulon's report as soon as it finalised. Thank you to everyone who completed Parent View.

It was fantastic to see such a large number of parents at our Parents' Evenings this week. The idea of this first meeting is for you to share your own observations about the beginning of the new school year and for the teachers to discuss where your child's key strengths and areas for further development are. I know that 10 minutes just never seems enough. If you need to discuss anything further with your child's teacher, please do stop by the office and make an additional appointment. Thank you for your comments and suggestions which I will be passing onto the Governors.

I am really thrilled to report that the school received its Inspection Dashboard from Ofsted. This reports the school as having a number of identified strengths and only one identified weakness. Our end of year results for 2016 were significantly higher than national figures and higher than Surrey figures for all key stages, with the exception of KS2 writing - which was in line with Surrey figures and continues to be an area for further improvement.

Last year there were significant changes to the assessment systems for children in years 1 to 6. As a school, we aim to get the vast majority of children to the EXPECTED standard in Reading, Writing and Maths by the end of the academic year and the most able children will aim to secure a greater depth of understanding and to SURPASS that standard.

Governors and the Senior Team are totally committed to improving standards, whilst continuing to ensure that our curriculum is enjoyable and nurtures all children.

We shall also be holding our open morning for prospective parents who are applying for places in September 2017. The meeting for children starting in YEAR 3 is on the 16th November at 9:30am at the WESTCOTT site and for children starting in RECEPTION the meeting is on the 17th November at 9:15 at the ABINGER site. Both sessions will begin with an introduction to the school by myself which will then be followed by tours with our Headboy and Headgirl along with a team of prefects.
