If your child has school dinners and you owe any money please can you pay via School Gateway as soon as possible. Meals should be paid for in advance.




Break Time Snacks

- The system will send a PIN code to your phone; please enter this PIN code and your account will be activated for you.

As soon as you've got the system set-up, you'll be able to pay money to the school online rather than send cash or cheques.
