Years 3/4 A team came first and the B team fourth. The Years 5/6 A team came first and the B team second. With 10 children winning individual medals. Well done to all those who part.





SURREY HILLS SCHOOL CHESS

Beginners Chess is held every Friday at 8am - 8.50am. The first club in 2018 will be Friday 12th January. The cost for the term is £50.00. To register and pay just follow the link: http://www.sportsreg.co.uk/surreyhillschess2018

Places will be offered on a first come first served basis. The closing date to register and pay is 8th January 2018.

During the Spring 2018 Term we will once again take part in the Delancey Schools UK Chess Challenge. This competition has been running for 23 years and last year attracted over 40,000 children from about 1280 schools and clubs up and down the country.

The first stage of the tournament is played once a week in school at chess club. Pairings are made on a simplified Swiss system: Win = 3 points; Draw or Stalemate = 2 points; Loss = 1 point. At the beginning of term, as soon as a player reaches 3 points, they will be given a badge. Players must take great care of their badges as they will be awarded gold spots to stick on them each time they accumulate another three points. There are also other prizes at 11 points and 15 points. Players with the highest score at the end of term in each age group qualify for the Area Megafinal held in May. Winners of that tournament will qualify for the Gigafinal taking place in July and winners from that will go on to play in The Terafinal taking place in August.


