'Think' Training

On Tuesday this week the children in Year 5 and 6 took part in some 'Think' training. The sessions were delivered by specialist teachers from Surrey and focused on the importance of treating everyone equally regardless of any differences. Discrimination in its various forms were discussed during the training and the children were taught to ask themselves five key questions before speaking:

T = Is it True?

H = Is it helpful?

I = Is it inspiring?

N = Is it Necessary?

K = Is it Kind?

We will be sharing this important message with the rest of the school in assembly time over the next couple of weeks.



During this half term, leading up to Easter, we are participating in The 40 Acts of Kindness initiative, which encourages people to mark Lent a bit differently. Lent marks a pivotal point in the history of the church, when Jesus prepared to give himself up as a sacrifice. Instead of 'giving up' something for Lent, the children and staff have been encouraged to perform simple acts of kindness at school.

Each class have a set of kindness challenges from which they choose their daily 'act'. Since it is individual to each class, each class may be doing something different. As well as being fun to see if they can guess what a particular class's act for the day is, it is helping to promote our deep-rooted Christian values, which are such an important aspect to life at Surrey Hills.
