Healthier snacking for children

How much sugar is in a child's snack?

Do you really know how much sugar is in the average child's snack? Children across England are consuming nearly three times their daily recommended amount of sugar with half of this sugar coming from snacks and sugary drinks. Too much sugar can lead to harmful fat building up, which can develop into serious health issues as well as tooth decay. But some small changes to their diet can make a big difference.

When choosing snacks for the kids, look for 100 calorie snacks two a day max





Alternative Snacks

Try healthier options by swapping biscuits, sweets and crisps for healthier snacks like fruit and vegetables, fruited malt loaf, fromage frais, popcorn, houmous or rice cakes. Look out for the Change4Life signs at selected supermarkets to find healthier options and follow this simple tip '100 calorie snacks, two a day max.'

Next week (5th- 9th February) is **Keeping Safe Week**. During this week, the children will be discussing ways they can keep safe at school, at home and in the local area. Throughout the week, the younger children will be learning about water and road safety and the older children will be learning about rail safety.

In addition to this, we are taking in part in the Global Safer Internet Day on 6th February which will be looking at how to use the Internet responsibly. We will be reminding the children about how to stay safe using age appropriate videos.

In KS1, we will be using NSPCC's Pantosaurus video clip, to teach children the underwear rule. You can view this video clip using the link below. Other clips we will be using during the week are listed below.
