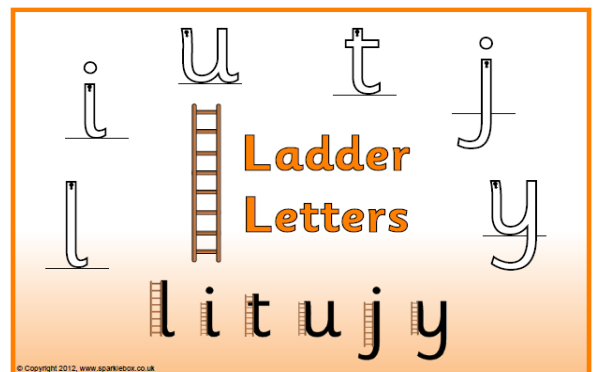

Daily Expectations

10 minutes Phonics

This should include recapping of all the sounds that have previously been learnt, building CVC words (e.g. sat, tap, pin) tricky word recognition.

15 minutes Number and/or Shape

This could include counting forwards and backwards to 10, recognition of numbers, especially to 10, ordering and sequencing, 1 more and 1 less than a given number. Names and simple properties of 2D and 3D shapes.

10 minutes Handwriting

Continue to practice correct letter **and** number formation. This could be practicing writing their name or the current phonics focus.

See 'Fine and Gross Motor' document on the school website. There are lots of fun and practical ideas that you can do in your garden or with resources at home.
